Directions for Room Walk Peer Response

*Before students begin writing, teacher assigns number of methods each class is to use according to their ability.

*Students should refer to their Methods of Elaboration sheet.

When to Use Room Walk:

*For each Room Walk, students add to the same two pages in order to give the writer a comprehensive picture of the Methods of Elaboration used. Writers should revise as needed.

After introduction & 1^{st} body (Go to 4 peers' desks) After 2^{nd} body (4 peers) After 3^{rd} body & conclusion (4 peers)

How to Use:

Student writers leave their writing and Room Walk sheets at their desks

Students then go to four peers' desks

In specified time, students quote from a peer's essay examples of as many methods as possible before the teacher tells the class it is time to move to another desk

"Others" may be used for Smiley-Face Tricks.

Purpose: Emphasize Methods of Elaboration & give writers chance to revise.
